1. General Business

2. Old Business

 - i. Allyson noted that the auction made over \$63,500.
 - ii. Carrie thanked Allyson and said she did an amazing job. Carrie noted that without everyone's continued efforts we could not have the specialist like our music and art teachers.

- a. Community Outreach Fundraising – Laura Berlant & Emily Stearn

- c. Measure V & THE Foundation – Felice Becker

 - iii. Carrie and Grace thanked Felice for spearheading.

She can tell them it is not appropriate and let the parents know.

- c. Mrs. Brazell said they are highlighting either a grade level or an assembly in each Cub Corner so that everyone can have a better understanding about the school and not just their own grade level.
- d. Mrs. Brazell said they anticipate all of the music performances to be something special. They are all working so hard. She is even dressing up for the kinder performance.
- e. Mrs. Brazell noted that with the scholastic dollars they purchased materials for the maker space in the library. It is an area in the library where the kids can come and create. There are going to be Lego boards, a gears table, new rugs. They divided the rest of the scholastic dollars for the teachers and they can shop in the scholastic catalog.
- f. Mrs. Brazell discussed the coronavirus. She said they are trying hard to keep the classrooms clean and have added disinfectant to every room. The teachers are being trained tomorrow on google meets in case they have to do some teaching from home. They want to make sure everyone is trained and ready.
